

Provisions in OMIG Audit Reform Bill for 2025:

- Requirement that OMIG must apply the **laws, regs, policies, guidelines in effect at the time the claim/conduct occurred** when conducting audits
- Provider shall be afforded right to **lower confidence level even if they pursue a hearing/appeal** and recoupment cannot commence until 60 days after final audit report or if a provider pursues a hearing, 60 days after the final determination is made
- Allows for **correction of administrative/technical errors** and OMIG will recoup funds for that particular error, but the bill states that no further action can be taken by OMIG related to the corrected errors (meaning no extrapolation without saying that word).
- New section providing for more **reasonable timeframes for OMIG self-disclosure requirements**
- Requirement for annual report to **consider provider/service impact** of auditing activities
- Includes all-encompassing statement that **nothing in the bill shall limit NY's ability to comply with federal auditing requirements**
- Effective date changed to **4/1/26 so no impact on SFY 2025-26**
