RE: Funding Opportunity Notice

Dear Provider,

Your organization has been identified as eligible to receive additional funding through the Opioid Stewardship fund to support treatment affordability for uninsured and underinsured individuals in outpatient services for up to two years. The *preliminary* amount in Year 1 is <\$\$\$\$\$\$\$>. The amount was calculated by analyzing uncompensated care expenses using 2022 and 2023 data from your filed Consolidated Fiscal Report (CFR) for your outpatient services. Funds should be used in support of outpatient services offered by your agency. The additional funds will be budgeted to a single outpatient PRU. Providers may use their discretion in moving the funds between appropriate PRUs within your provider organization, either by submitting budget changes or as part of the claiming and reconciliation process. This amount may be allocated across any other funded outpatient, outpatient rehab, or opioid treatment program PRUs associated with the <PROVIDER #> provider number.

Please be aware that if your outpatient program is not currently funded with OASAS State aid, you will be required to budget and claim your clinic for the duration of this award in order to receive the funds. In accordance with current year-end funding reconciliation rules, if the outpatient program reports a surplus in the CFR, and the provider has other State Aid funded programs within a single county SAFA or contract, the surplus of the outpatient clinic will be shifted to address operational deficits of the other funded programs. If the outpatient clinic reports a surplus and is the only program within a single county SAFA or contract, State Aid will be recovered.

A failure to respond by **COB on Friday, August 8, 2025**, will be considered a passive declination of funding. There will not be an opportunity to opt into the funding opportunity at a later date. Interested organizations will receive an official award letter with a final amount and further instructions for next steps to initiate the receipt of funding.
